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General Welfare Requirement: Suitable People

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One manager or deputy is on the premises at all times to supervise all staff members.

Staff members are all qualified first aiders -
These courses are updated every 3 years

All staff members have had records checked -
Checks made by DBS in way of disclosures, staff that are unvetted **do not** have unsupervised access to the children

All staff members are up to date with all written policies -
Staff meeting once a term to update any changes

All staff members undertake training -
Courses when available are attended by staff to update knowledge and skills

Rotas are in place every session, so staff members are able to carry out daily routines

Long term, medium term and daily continuous provision Plans -
Are available every session and can be followed so staff members are up to date with daily activities and the focus behind them.
