# **Procedures**

Children who are not collected on time by their main carer by:-

- 12 noon morning session
- 1.00pm lunch club
- 3pm/4pm afternoon sessions
- 6pm full day

Children, who are not collected within 10 minutes of their designated time, will be charged £10 and £5 for every 5 minutes thereafter.

Any child left for a period of 1 hour, after trying all contact numbers given to us by you, the current legislation requires that we inform the local Social Services / OFSTED department.
